We, GNB Industrial Power (UK) Limited and Exide Technologies (Transportation) Limited are committed to fulfilling our obligations under the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009 ("the Regulations").

Both companies are registered battery producers with the National Packaging Waste Database under number BPRN00294 (for GNB) and BPRN00278 (for Exide).

Take Back: Industrial Batteries

As a producer of industrial batteries under the Regulations we, **GNB Industrial Power (UK) Limited** have produced lead-acid chemistry type industrial batteries which have been placed or intended to be placed on the market during this calendar year and the preceding three years. More recently we have produced lithium chemistry type industrial batteries which have been placed or intended to be placed on the market during this calendar year and the preceding two years.

We are obliged to take back free of charge, waste industrial batteries supplied to an end user for treatment and recycling. We are required to do this in any calendar year we place new industrial batteries on the market.

Collection: Automotive Batteries

As a producer of automotive batteries under the Regulations we, **Exide Technologies** (**Transportation**) **Limited** are obliged to collect, free of charge and within a reasonable time, waste automotive batteries for treatment and recycling from final holders e.g. garages, scrap yards, end-of-life vehicle authorised treatment facilities, Civic Amenity Sites, etc. We are required to do this in any calendar year we place new automotive batteries on the market.
